Mission Statement

The mission of the House of Hope is to provide alcohol and drug abuse treatment services to those who are most in need, so that they may reach their productive capacity, and enjoy those gifts of life that are only available in sobriety.



Men's Residential

The Adult Residential Program provides 20 adult males with a structured treatment program for alcohol and drug dependency.

The House of Hope Adult Residential Program offers recovering men the information, counseling and support needed to understand and accept their disease and its consequences. Men in this program learn new coping skills to function successfully without alcohol and drugs.

Length of Treatment

All admissions are voluntary. Clients are asked for a commitment of 6 months. Residents will have successfully completed the program when they have maintained sobriety, secured employment and safe housing, and developed a sober support network.

Aftercare

Clients who complete the Adult Residential Program may participate in Aftercare Services. These services may include planning, referral, transitional housing, and aftercare support groups.



Outpatient Program

The Outpatient Program offers services that are designed to meet the individual needs of men and women to recover from alcohol and drug dependency or abuse.

The Outpatient Program services are designed to minimize disruptions to work and educational opportunities by allowing participants to meet at convenient hours.

Intensive Outpatient

The Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) consists of 8 weeks of treatment, with a minimum of 24 sessions. The sessions are held three times per week, Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 6:00 pm until 9:00 pm. Participants are also involved in individual sessions with their counselor. Completion of primary treatment is followed by 6 weeks of relapse prevention aftercare.

Women's IOP

The House of Hope has recognized a community need for specialized treatment for women suffering from alcohol/drug problems sometimes combined with issues such as depression, major anxiety, family and relationship problems, and post-traumatic stress disorders among others. This program meets during the day 3 days per week; Tuesday 12-2, Wednesday 12-3 and Thursday 12-3 pm.

Individualized Outpatient

This Outpatient Program typically meets once or twice per week. Group sessions are arranged to meet the individual's needs based on the severity of their alcohol and/or drug use. Participants are also involved in individual sessions with their counselor.

Certification

The House of Hope, Inc. is certified by the Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services. The staff providing services is caring and experienced in the field of chemical dependency. All clinicians are licensed by the State of Ohio.

Cost of Treatment

The House of Hope, Inc. is funded by the United Way, Franklin County ADAMH Board, the Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services, The Columbus Foundation, the Franklin County Department of Jobs and Family Services, and generous private donors. Client payment is based on a sliding fee scale. Most of our residents qualify for no or reduced charges for our services.
